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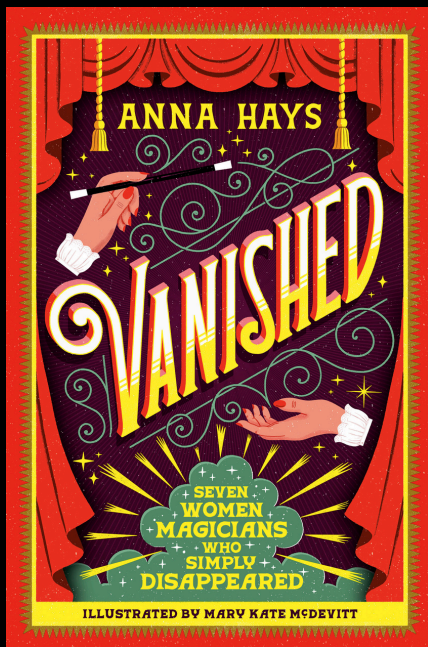

VANISHED IS A MIDDLE GRADE NONFICTION BOOK SHINING A LIGHT ON THE FORGOTTEN LIVES OF SEVEN ICONIC WOMEN MAGICIANS WHO SIMPLY DISAPPEARED FROM HISTORY. MAGICIANS ANNA EVA FAY, ADELAIDE HERRMANN, DIXIE HAYGOOD, MERCEDES TALMA, MINERVA, BESS HOUDINI, AND ELLEN ARMSTRONG PERFORMED DURING THE GOLDEN AGE OF MAGIC (1860-1930), DEFIED VICTORIAN CONVENTIONS, AND CREATED A UNIQUE PLACE IN THE HISTORY OF MAGIC. YET TODAY, THERE IS HARDLY A WHISPER ABOUT THEIR IMPACT ON THE WORLD OF ENTERTAINMENT. DURING A TIME WHEN WOMEN WERE TYPICALLY CONFINED TO THE HOME AND EXPECTED TO RAISE CHILDREN AND PERFORM DOMESTIC DUTIES, THESE TRAILBLAZERS CROSSED OCEANS ON STEAMSHIPS AND TRAVELED THE GLOBE BRINGING THEIR IMAGINATIVE BRAND OF MAGIC TO AUDIENCES AROUND THE WORLD. THEY FOLLOWED THEIR HEARTS AND PURSUED THEIR DREAMS OF PERFORMING MAGIC IN THE SPOTLIGHT WHEN WOMEN HAD NEITHER A VOTE NOR A VOICE IN AMERICA. VANISHED INTRODUCES THESE COLORFUL, COMPLICATED AND UNCONVENTIONAL WOMEN, SHARING TRUE STORIES THAT REVEAL THEIR CREATIVITY, ADAPTABILITY, AND NOTORIETY — ALL OF WHICH HAVE BEEN HIDDEN BEHIND A VEIL OF MYSTERY AND ILLUSION — UNTIL NOW.
